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Weddings & Events - Safety Plan -

Updated December 7, 2020

- All resort-hosted dining events, weddings, elopements, and specialty events are subject to limited guest (patron) numbers. **Update as of December 7th:** Weddings and funerals are allowed for up to 10 people including staff. A maximum of 7 guests are permitted. This policy is in effect until January 8th, 2021, but may be revised as provincial public health orders are announced.
- Masks must be worn by everyone in all indoor spaces.
- Events can only be hosted from noon until 11:00pm, and no event will take place before or after one scheduled event at the same location, in one day.
- An event room will be cleaned and sanitized prior to the next event in the same premises.
- If live music is provided (performer(s) or DJ), a physical barrier must be installed between the performer(s) and the patrons.
- All staff will be wearing masks.
- All patron-hosted dining events, weddings, elopements, and specialty events are limited to 10 patrons, including staff. This policy is in effect until January 8th, 2021, but may be revised as provincial public health orders are announced.
- Patrons who leave the premises during the event must not be replaced by other patrons.
- Additional patrons may be present in other areas of our resort.
- Patrons and staff are always required to practice social and physical distancing by remaining 2 or more metres apart.
- No more than six patrons will be seated at a table
- Dining is available in individual servings, family style, or take-out.
- Masks must be worn by all diners upon entrance to the dining area, and may only be removed while eating and drinking.
- If staff, at a food service or payment counter, cannot maintain a distance of two or more metres from other patrons, staff and patrons will be separated by a washable, rigid, impermeable partition that:
 - » *extends from the counter to at least 1.20 metres above the food service or payment counter.*
 - » *hangs to the countertop and is at least 1.20 metres above the food service or payment counter if it is hung from the ceiling or another structure.*
- Safety markers and signage are in place to support social and physical distancing.
- All surfaces are sanitized frequently throughout the day including high traffic areas, public restrooms, and door handles.

- Automated hand-sanitizer stations are available in highly-visible areas throughout the resort.
- All guests and staff must wash their hands frequently and for a minimum of 45 seconds before touching self-service food, utensils, and other items.
- All event organizers are responsible for collecting the following information from all of their guests, which must be provided to the Sandpiper Resort Event Manager. This information will be kept on file for 30 days should there be a need for contact tracing by a medical health officer.
 - » *First and last name*
 - » *Telephone number*
 - » *Email address*

While we have always maintained high sanitation procedures, based on provincial and federal government recommendations and orders, we are strictly adhering to further guidelines:
